SCRIPTURE - Romans 4:13-18

- 1. What do we think of the phrase "righteousness of faith " in verse 13? Do we think about our daily lives in terms of righteousness and unrighteousness, or faithfulness or unfaithfulness to Christ and others? What default frameworks do we use to get through the day?
- 2. Verse 15 says that "For the law brings wrath, but where there is no law there is no transgression." What was the purpose of the law (the Torah)? Would all of us be better off if God didn't give it to His people?
- 3. In the latter part of verse 17, it says that God "gives life to the dead and calls into existence the things that do not exist." What are some examples in our lives that testify to God bringing life to things seemingly dead or defying certain realities that we thought were unchangeable?
